Drag and Drop it onto our image.



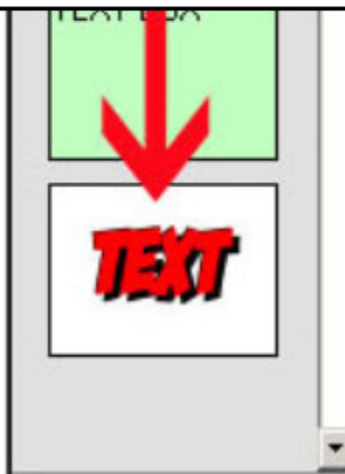
We can resize our balloons by
dragging the red squares



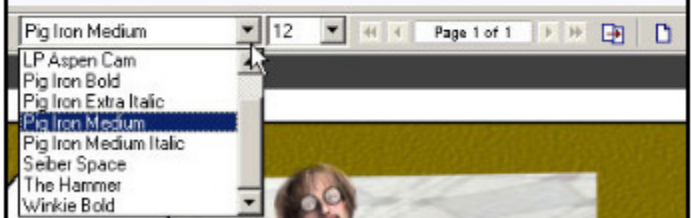
We can alter the size and

the Green boxes.



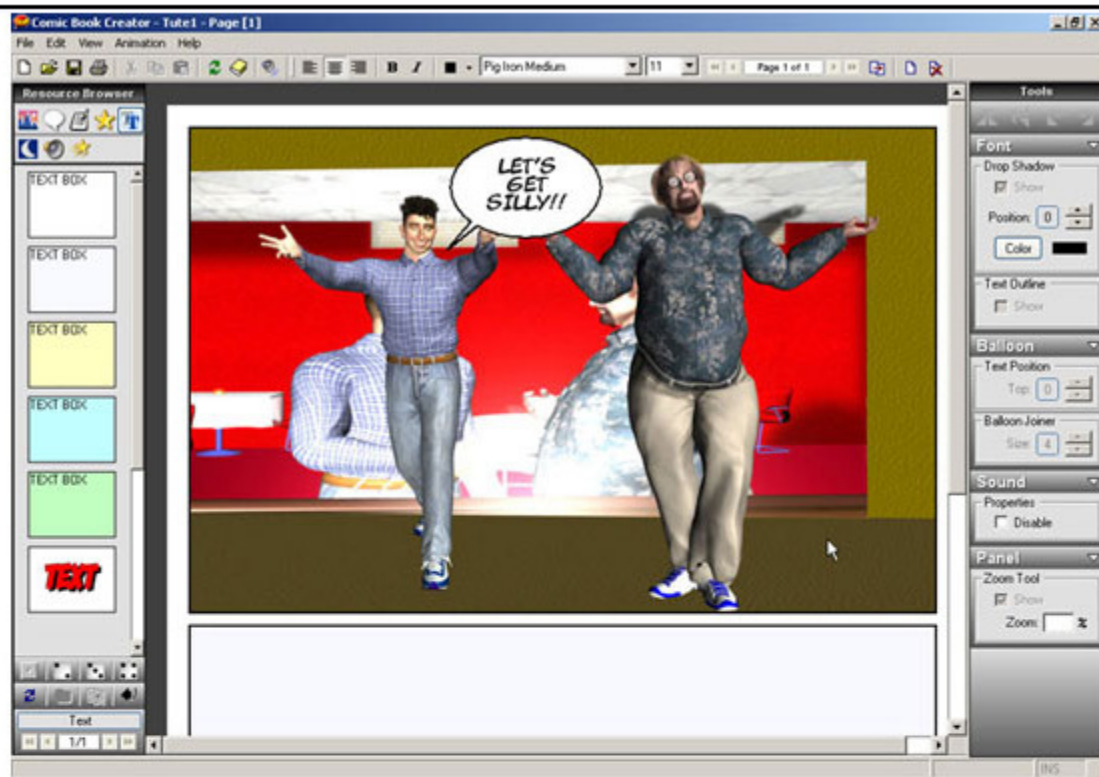
If we use the black

text alignment, etc.

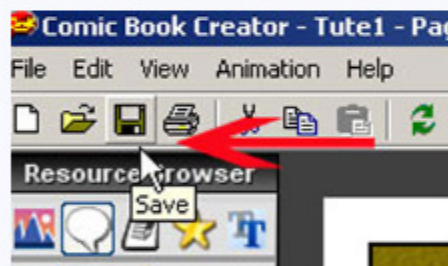


Let's type the text.

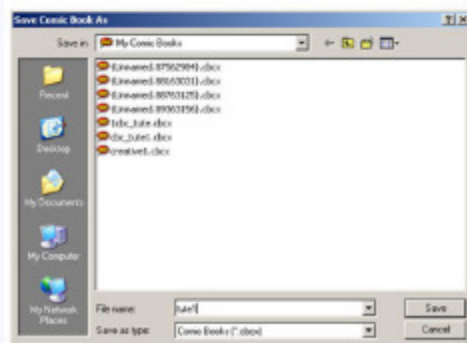




Let's type some text.



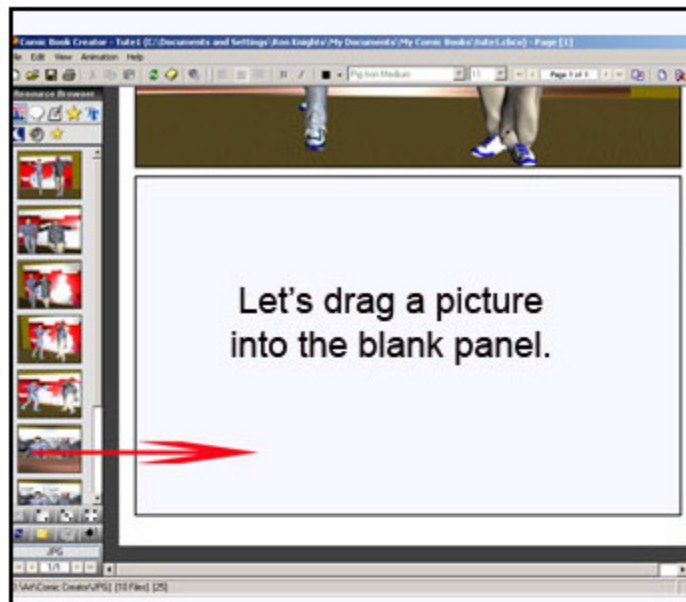
Let's save our comic.

location.

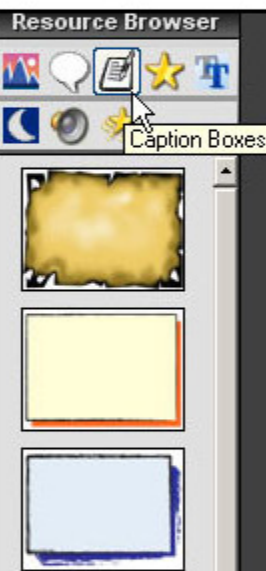


Let's add another picture.

caption box.



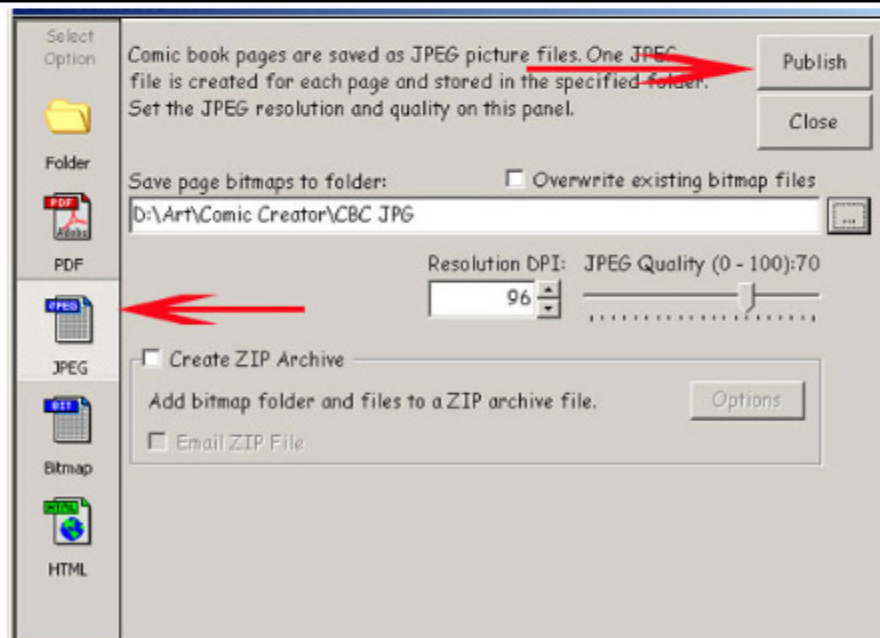
Let's resize that box!
