A STIPULATION FOR INTERIM SUSPENSION OF LICENSE TO PRACTICE LAW was filed by the parties in the above entitled case on December 28, 2011, requesting the Idaho Supreme Court enter an Order of interim suspension of attorney John T. Bujak upon the terms and conditions set forth in the Stipulation. The Court is fully advised; therefore, good cause appearing,


IT HEREBY IS ORDERED that the STIPULATION FOR INTERIM SUSPENSION OF
LICENSE TO PRACTICE LAW be, and hereby is, GRANTED.

IT FURTHER IS ORDERED that Respondent John T. Bujak, be, and hereby is, IMMEDIATELY PLACED UPON A PERIOD OF INTERIM SUSPENSION OF LICENSE TO PRACTICE LAW in the State of Idaho, pursuant to I.B.C.R. 510(a)(1) until all disciplinary matters referred to in the Stipulation are concluded.

IT FURTHER IS ORDERED that pursuant to the stipulation of the parties, all disciplinary matters referred to in the Stipulation will be held in abeyance consistent with I.B.C.R. 525(g) and the Fifth Amendment until the pending criminal charges are concluded at the state district court level and the time Respondent John T. Bujak spends on interim suspension shall be credited toward any eventual sanction he may receive as a result of any of the disciplinary matters referred to in the Stipulation.
