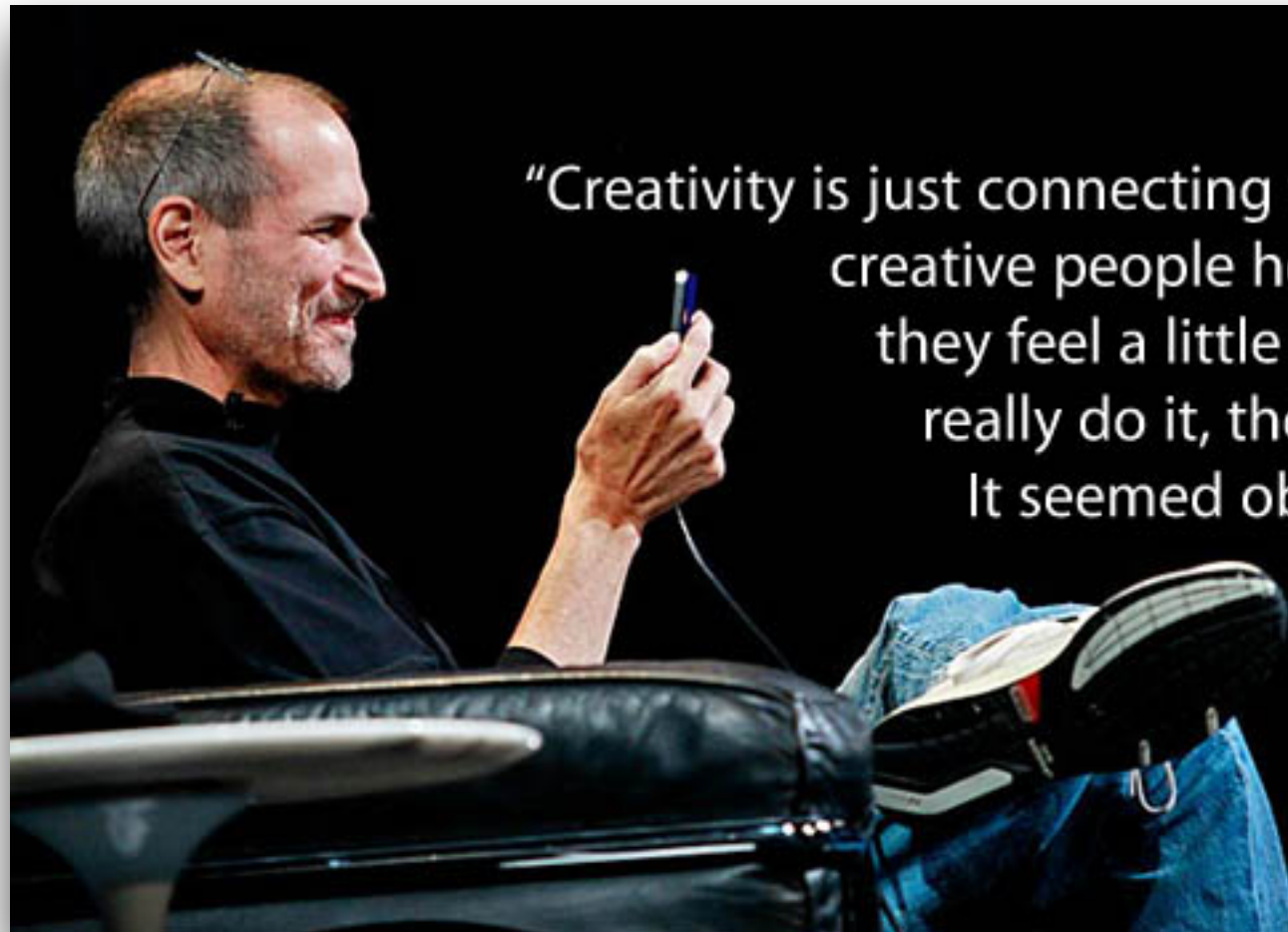
What is creativity?

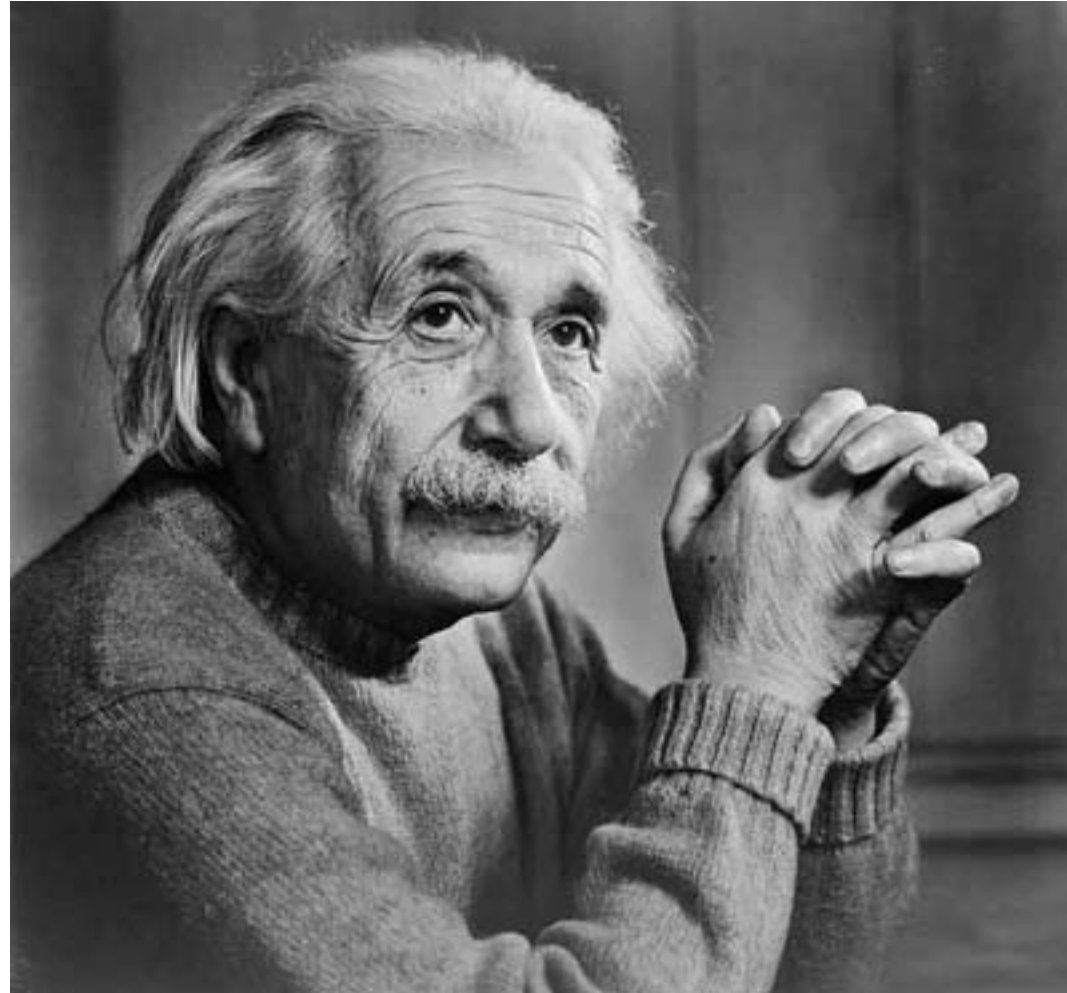

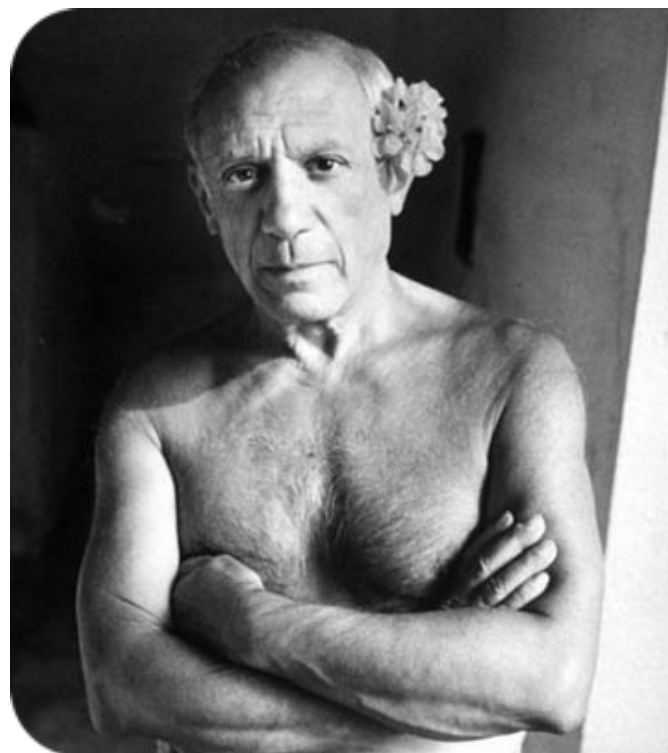

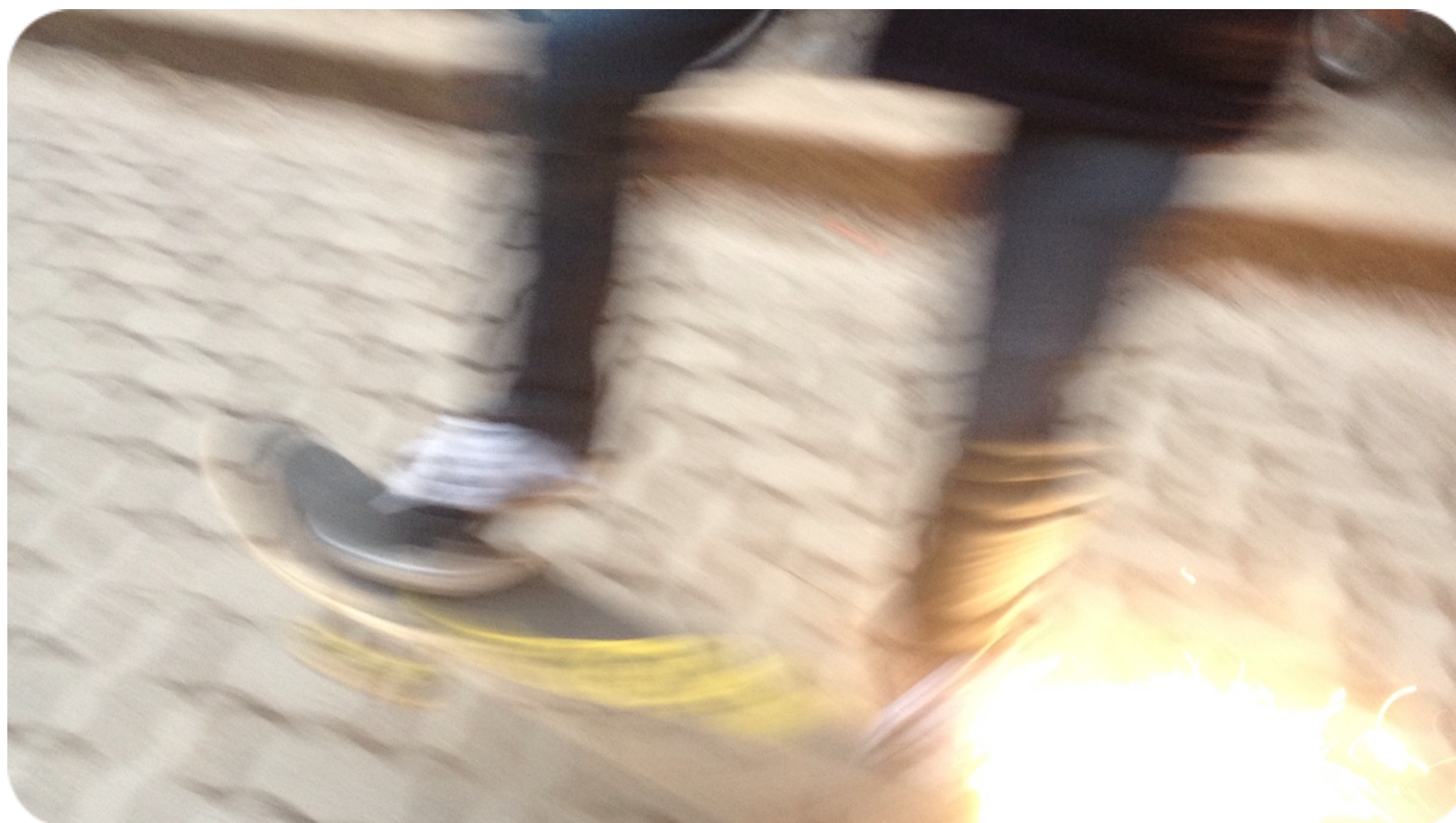
