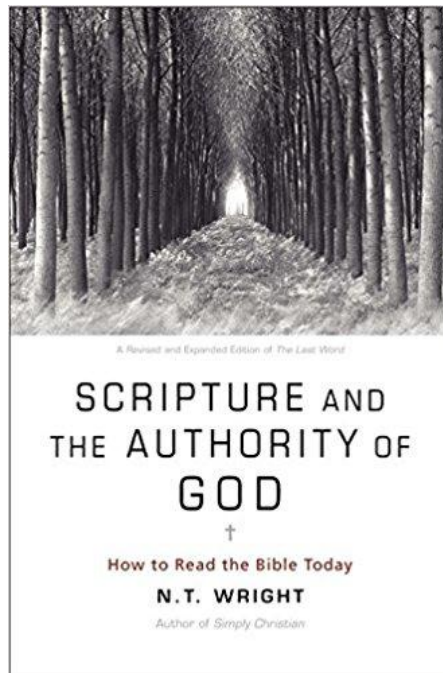


# Exploring Scripture
