Wheelhouse has numerous options for private group tours. Take a look at the six we recommend!

Near East Side - 8 to 16 miles, 2 - 3 hrs

This tour showcases Detroit's most unique attractions, including the Dequindre Cut, Heidelberg Project, Earthworks Urban Farm, Eastern Market, the Mies van der Rohe Lafayette Park development, Elmwood Cemetery and the Detroit RiverWalk. Optional stops include Belle Isle and Indian Village.



Detroit RiverWalk/Dequindre Cut - approx. 5 miles, 2 hrs

Ideal for families, this tour is almost entirely on greenways, separated from auto traffic. Short and sweet, it focuses on the beautifully renewed RiverWalk and the Dequindre Cut rail-to-trail.

Beers & Bikes! - approx. 10 miles, 3 hrs

Michigan beer has a great reputation around the country, and this tour will show you why! Stops will vary depending on time and date, but might include Atwater Brewery, Motor City Brewing Works, Detroit Beer Co., Traffic Jam & Snug, Park Bar and/or Foran's Grand Trunk Pub.

Corktown - approx. 8 miles, 3 hrs

Get inside info on Detroit's oldest neighborhood, including charming Victorian homes, historic churches and buildings and vibrant and dynamic businesses. A stop at a pub or cafe can be arranged. (Starts at \$200)



Eastern Market - approx. 5 miles, 2 - 3 hrs

This tour takes in the Dequindre Cut, Lafayette Park and the historic market. A lunch stop at renowned Supino Pizza can be arranged. Recommended for Tuesday and Saturdays.

Belle Isle - approx. 15 miles, 3 hrs

Explore the architecture of Detroit's island gem, including the Eero Saarinen-designed Flynn Pavilion, the Albert Kahn-designed Aquarium, the Boat and Yacht Clubs, the Casino and Livingstone Lighthouse. A sampling of the park's numerous statues will be discussed, including General Alpheus Starkey Williams and his famous horse Plug Ugly and Scott Fountain. The tours may include stops at the Aquarium, Conservatory, Nature Center and/or Dossin Great Lakes Museum.

Three-hour group tours start at \$200 for up to six people; additional riders cost \$30 per person or \$40 with a bike rental. Groups up to 20 can be accommodated. Each tour includes a custom printed map for each rider, an experienced tour guide to lead and a sweeper that can help out with any mechanical problems that may arise. Please note that an entirely custom tour can also be designed, but the cost will vary. Tour prices may vary according to length, and whether or not a food stop or guest speaker is included. Reservations must be made in advance and a \$50 non-refundable deposit is required to secure a time and date. Email bookings@wheelhousedetroit.com to get started!
