Benson was the one who started new work in Batangas and Ralph Julian is a foreign missionary in Oman for 2 years now. Jon Jon is the one in Bicol area. Another 7 young people from the children home, Epharaim, Cedric, May, Riza, Jennifer, Rosalie and Precious, are all new enrolles of our Bible College.
