P.S. - Please pray for Brother Perfecto Castro. ^{Tied him to Christ some years ago.} Love in Christ

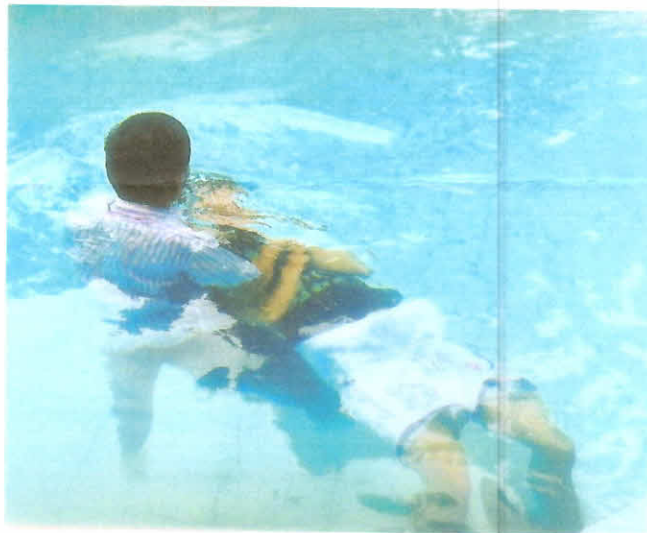
