I have returned from a trip to Cambodia and had much accomplished. One of the issues I had to address was security. We had the wire cut above our block wall where some thieves gained access to our compound and by pulling the gate off it's hinges were able to steal our motorcycle. We purchased a new motorcycle to replace the one which was taken and purchased motion sensor lights as well as hired a contractor to raise up the block wall, top it with glass and razor wire and put on a new, solid gate. The most popular change with the children was the new guard dog we bought. "Gypsy" a 2 month old golden retriever, which the children love, will hopefully grow up to be a good watch dog for the orphanage as well as a pet for the children . Ten of our children from Phnom Penh have been relocated to the new facility in Seam Reap and the children have bonded into a family. They are all healthy and very happy. With the increase in children it was necessary to hire another couple to work as house parents. They will locate on the first floor and be parents to the children located there. Bro Roth and his wife will continue to watch the children on the second floor as well as the administration which does take a lot of Bro Roth's time He has also started a Bible study with several families and the church there is also growing.
