This past month I had the opportunity to again visit the areas still affected by the storm. We were able to have a distribution of Bibles and other Christian materials to help these pastors who had lost everything. Some pastors were even pastoring without complete Bibles! The two boys you see in the top left are pastors' sons who were so excited to finally have a Bible again. We had the distribution in the church on the bottom right. You can see in the background that their building is still a tent. They have not yet been able to rebuild. In the bottom left, you can see a ship that was brought ashore by the storm and has still not been removed. One of the most touching parts of the distribution is when the children in the upper right picture got up and sang "Till the Storm Passes By". These children remember the storm clearly and I heard the testimony of one boy who had to swim two kilometres before finding a roof that had room for him. Its a privilege to meet these people and to be able to work with the people back home to bring relief to the people still affected by Typhoon Hiyan.
