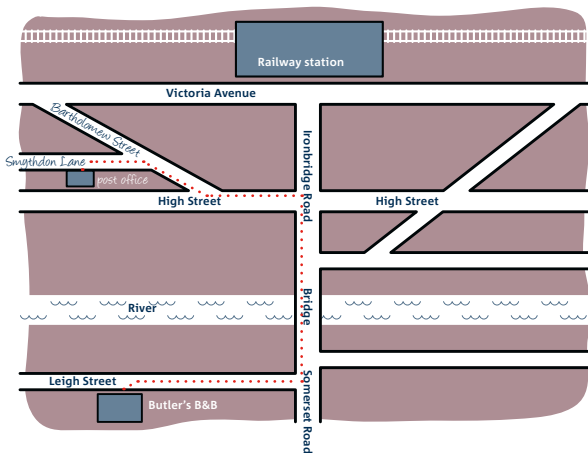

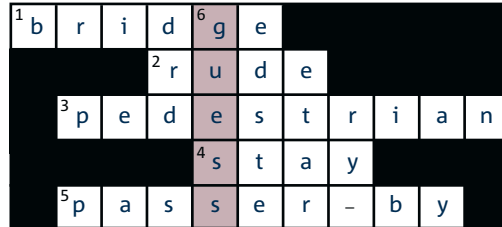

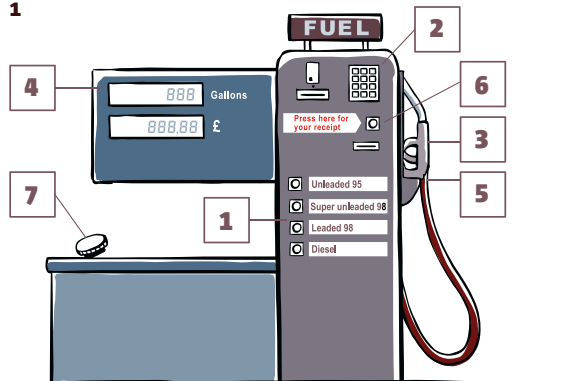

Once they have received the documents and payment they will send you an e-mail to tell you that the search has begun.

They will also send you the details of your personal researcher, who will remain in contact through e-mail and send regular updates.

All searches will remain strictly confidential.

Once the search has been completed, they recommend using an adoption intermediary service, which means that they contact your birth relative for you because this gives your birth relative time to think. (This will give you a much higher chance that your birth relative will welcome contact.)
