SEEK GOD'S FACE

We believe that what our city needs most and what is required for us to accomplish our mission is a focus on developing and empowering spiritual leaders. This means we want to focus our efforts to provide more support for current leaders and to be a launching pad for future leaders.

REFLECT THE DIVERSITY OF OUR CITY, AND OF GOD'S NEW CITY

We believe God is calling us to be a church that reflects the diversity of our city and a church that reflects the diversity and inclusion of *God's new city*. We long to be a community where diverse gifts, voices, perspectives, and stories join in harmony to pursue kingdom renewal.
