Tutor: Caroline Bell




Through experimentation with a variety of leaf material and fabric and paper students will gain an understanding of how the eco printing process works. Students will experiment with a variety of mordants, both metallic and natural substances, such as egg and soya milk to see how this affects outcomes. It is anticipated that students will go away with a wealth of information regarding which leaf material gives the best results and how external factors can alter outcome. Examples include: composition of container in which the process takes place; water; climatic conditions etc. At the end of the workshop students will end up with a sample cloth, a silk scarf and a selection of papers, with ideas about how to take the process further.

## Marvellous Monoprinting Sat 6th June

Explore mono-printing and quickly create a selection of marvellous printed papers and textiles. Enjoy using various water soluble media, such as Neocolour II, Derwent Art Bars and Procion MX dyes that you can draw and paint onto a blank silk-screen. Then using various carriers such as Manutex, print your image onto various papers and fabrics creating a collection of unique painterly prints. Layer your imagery and vary your marks with various resists and stencils.

By the end of the day you will have the confidence to continue with these techniques at home as well as have a big selection of finished pieces plus some favourites that you may want to stitch or appliqué together. Suitable for all levels of experience, this workshop is a great way to quickly explore some imagery and develop marks whilst having a lot of fun along the way!

fabrics into a unique pieced 'nuno' scarf.
