Where

Do will take place at Payne's Hut, Fitzgerald Road, Glen Valley, Victoria, Australia. It is set alongside the Mitta Mitta River, surrounded by gum trees. It's a magical setting.

Payne's Hut is approx. 6.5-7hrs drive from Melbourne and 12hrs from Sydney. Previous DO-ers have connected via our Twitter car share account, others travelled by train to

Albury and hired a car. You could even hire a helicopter! More travel information will be provided once 'you're in'.

When

The event runs from the afternoon of Thursday 19 March and finishes after breakfast on Sunday 22 March 2015.

Am I in?

Once you have filled in your application and mailed it to us, we will let you know pretty quickly.

Payment

Payment of ticket will be required in full by 19 February to confirm your place. If we haven't received payment by that date, unfortunately we'll need to release your place.

The event, we know from previous years and in other countries, will be over-subscribed. A payment plan may be available on request.

Cancellation policy

This is a small event. We hand pick the speakers. And we do the same for the audience. If you are accepted, it means someone else isn't. So before you commit, please give it some thought as to how much you really want to be here.

If you need to cancel your ticket for any reason, we will try to re-sell your ticket. If we are successful, we will refund 80% of the ticket price.
