

First Week 10 Study Questions

Discussion Starters:

How would you describe or define evangelism?

How do you do evangelism in your life now?

In your journey to faith in Christ, how did evangelism happen in your life?

What are the roles of the individual and the church in evangelism?

Read Colossians 4:2-4:6

What immediately catches your attention? Does anything in this passage particularly confuse you, encourage you or convict you?

(v. 2) What does Paul mean by being steadfast, watchful and thankful as we pray?

How would you describe your prayer life? (sparse, full, joyful, dull . . .)

(v. 3-4) What does Paul's prayer request say about his perspective? How often do you pray this request for yourself and others?

(v. 5) How do we walk in wisdom toward outsiders?

How does a (doctor, farmer, businesswoman) make the best use of their time? What are some ways you (as a Christian) can begin to make "the best use of the time"?

Through His Word, God calls us to be both gracious and bold in sharing the Gospel. How do we balance the two?

(v. 6) What does it mean for our speech to be seasoned with salt? How does our tongue detract from or promote Christ?

Why are our actions and our speech equally important when it comes to sharing Christ?

What are the key elements of the Good News we have to share?
