

First Week 4 Study Questions

Read Galatians 6:9

What is it about doing good that can make a person weary? Has this ever happened to you?

What are the warning signs that you may be growing weary?

Read Colossians 1:24-26

What does Paul point to as the reason why he serves churches like the Colossians? Read one of the accounts of Paul's conversion in Acts 9, Acts 23, or Acts 26 for even more clarity.

How did you come to know Christ? In your Bridge group, share part of your story.

Paul had a very specific calling to the Gentiles. How do we understand God's will for our lives? Support your answer with Scripture.

Read Colossians 1:29

What is the source of Paul's strength? In what way is Christ working within Paul?

How do we live with the same power?

Read Colossians 1:27:2:5

Paul suffered greatly (2 Corinthians 11:23-28), yet he not only continued to serve Christ, but he rejoiced in his sufferings (Colossians 1:24). What purpose was he trying to accomplish? What was the goal of all he did?

Read Matthew 28:18-20

This is a message given to all believers. What does Jesus say is our ultimate purpose? How are you doing in fulfilling that purpose?
