

Greater Week 1 Study Questions

Read 2 Timothy 3:16

This verse gives us four benefits of Scripture. It...

- 1) Teaches - sends us the right direction
- 2) Rebukes - warns us when we're going the wrong direction
- 3) Corrects - helps us get back on the right track
- 4) Trains - helps us stay on the right track

Give an example or two of a Scripture that has accomplished one of these purposes in your life?

Read Nahum 1:5, Habakkuk 2:18-20, and Zephaniah 3:17.

What do each of these verses say about the greatness of God? Describe how He is greater using the descriptions in these verses.

How does His greatness described in these verses connect to your life? What difference do these verses make in our lives today?

Read and memorize Nahum 1:7. If you're in a Bridge Group, make a commitment to the other members that you will memorize it by your next meeting.

Head Start: Read Nahum 1 in preparation for this Sunday. Record observations in the three areas below. TIP: The application part will be much easier if you've spent time engaging with the first two areas.

OBSERVATION - Make notes on what's described in the text. Be a detective in the text. Look for the who, what, when, where, why, and how. What's repeated? Are there comparisons/contrasts?

ASK QUESTIONS - If you don't understand something, write it down and seek out an answer.

APPLICATIONS - Think about the question: What difference does this make in my life?
