

Greater Week 2 Study Questions

Read Isaiah 55:8-9 and Romans 11:33-36

What do these verses tell us about God? How do these characteristics of God affect the way we live/think?

Read Proverbs 14:27

What does this verse claim about the fear of God?

In what ways does the book of Nahum point to God as greater and worthy to be feared?

If we are in Christ, what is there to gain from having a healthy fear of God?

We learned on Sunday that God is greater than creation, greater than the nations, and greater than us. Share one or two points of application or something else you learned.

Memorize Proverbs 14:27. If you're in a Bridge Group, make a commitment to the other members that you will memorize it by your next meeting.

Head Start: Read Nahum 2 and 3 in preparation for this Sunday. Record observations in the three areas below. TIP: The application part will be much easier if you've spent time engaging with the first two areas.

OBSERVATION - Make notes on what's described in the text. Be a detective in the text. Look for the who, what, when, where, why, and how. What's repeated? Are there comparisons/contrasts?

ASK QUESTIONS - If you don't understand something, write it down and seek out an answer.

APPLICATIONS - Think about the question: What difference does this make in my life?
