

Matthew 6 Study Questions

Read Acts 9:2

The verse doesn't specify why early Christians were called followers of the Way, but what do you think the name indicates about Christianity? How does 'the way' relate to salvation and living out our faith?

Read Matthew 6:19-34

(v. 32-33) What is the comparison made in these two verses?

How can we develop a "seek first" mindset?

How does seeking Him first free us from anxiety about earthly things?

What do you tend to get most anxious about?

What reasons are given in verses 25-31 about why we shouldn't be anxious?

What do verses 19-21 say about treasure and the condition of your heart?

What are examples of laying up treasure on earth versus laying up treasure in heaven?

Why does choosing to lay up treasures in heaven require trust?

Read 2 Corinthians 4:15

This verse captures the heart of the "multiply" part of our vision. If this were your purpose, how would it affect your day to day activities?

As The Bridge looks toward the future, which of these five areas are you doing well in and which can you ask God to help you improve?

1. Relationship with God - Yes, we can all improve, but have you been drawing closer to Him or are there steps that need to be taken to seek Him first?
2. Serving - Do you currently have an area of ministry where you serve?
3. Praying - Could you begin praying for the church and our community more? Maybe set a time everyday to spend 5 to 10 minutes praying for the Morrisville/Cary area and for The Bridge to make an impact.
4. Inviting - To serve the community the way we want we need more people. How can you be more intentional in inviting people to join us in extending grace?
5. Giving - We can only function properly if we all give. As we look to move in the coming years, pray about how your family can be part of helping us reach that goal.
