New Chapel Dedicated At Anna Louise Inn Rites

Dedicatory services for the new chapel at Anna Louise Inn, 300 Lytle St., were conducted yesterday afternoon. Bishop Henry W. Hobson of the Episcopal Diocese of Southern Ohio officiated. The chapel, which was placed by the Lawrence Home Association, is in a parlor off the lobby of the Inn. Anna Louise Inn was built and is operated by the Cincinnati Union Bethel, an organization which carries on a social welfare program. There are 278 young women now in residence at the Inn, of which John R. Powers is Superintendent.

Following the dedication yesterday a tea was held for clergy and members of the Boards of Union Bethel and the Lawrence Home Association.
