

ITG Video Page: Submission Guidelines

ITG is pleased to announce the launch of a new Vimeo site and Video page on the ITG Members Site. This new content is available for all ITG registered members. The video content will include a Masterclass Series and Performance Series that will be frequently updated.

The first installments of the Masterclass Series included videos from Stephen Burns and Carl Saunders. The Performance Series of videos began with trumpet fanfares performed by various university trumpet ensembles from Ohio and KY. These fanfares were part of the Ohio ITG 2012 Fanfare Project that was commissioned by James Olcott, trumpet professor of Miami University (Oxford, OH).

Members will also have the opportunity to submit videos for consideration.

ITG Video Submission Guidelines

ITG members that are interested in submitting videos to be posted in the ITG Members-Only website must meet the following requirements:

1. Video is a minimum of four minutes and a maximum of twelve minutes (time not mandatory, but must be close).
2. Video quality must be of the highest quality possible (HD).
3. For videos to be considered, you must have created and/or have permission to use all content, including video and still imagery, words and music.
4. Performer and Composer Release forms must accompany videos to be considered. They can be downloaded on the video page.
5. An information form must accompany videos to be considered. The form includes the date of performance, name of performer(s), name of piece and composer, and the name of the person who recorded the video. Forms can be downloaded on the video page.
6. Submission of video does not guarantee use or publication.

Here are a few suggestions of the types of videos we look for:

- Brass Pedagogy (masterclass series)
- Historical (masterclass series)
- Music Business (masterclass series)
- Trumpet Performance (solo and chamber)

Helpful tips to making a good video:

- Stabilize or steady the camcorder when shooting. * When interviewing artists, capture their head & chest making sure your subject is fully in the picture. (ie: if a person is speaking - don't cut off their head).
- Make sure you've captured good speaking voices. Voices should be heard loud and clear.
- Background volume should be considered when someone is speaking. Don't record if the background noise is loud - this includes music!
- Consider your lighting. Don't point the camera into the sun or lighting - also, make sure it's not too dark.
- Record in the highest quality possible (video and audio).

Copyright and intellectual property

For videos to be considered for the ITG website, you must have created and/or have permission to use all content, including video and still imagery, words and music.

Appearance releases

ITG requires that signed release forms accompany all videos considered for posting on the Web. The release forms for performers and composers can be uploaded at: <http://members.trumpetguild.org/content/videos>

2. Composer release form (.pdf).

Copies of all signed forms must be submitted with your video submission.

File formats and transfers

The easiest ways for members of ITG to share video files are:

- the largest Quicktime (.mov) or Windows Media Player (.avi) file that you can fit on a DVD, delivered to: Dr. Raquel Rodriquez, Assistant Professor of Trumpet, Northern Kentucky University, Department of Music, Nunn Drive, Fine Arts Center 366, Highland Heights, KY 41099.
