NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Other rule changes will be noted in the sailing instructions.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This event is an invitation only regatta with celebrity skippers. The skippers for all invited boats will be past event Mystery Guests or past E fleet legends. Eligibility is open to boats in the E Class that meet invitation criteria as selected by the regatta committee.
- 2.2 The pairing of boats and skipper will be announced on Thursday, September 24 before the end of registration.
- 2.3 All boats will compete with four crew members. The invited team can decide who will sail with their paired skipper as long as there are four crew members for racing.
- 2.4 Invited boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it to the below address:

- 2.5 The Pewaukee Yacht Club will make every attempt to accommodate invited participant teams who require housing.

3 FEES

- 3.1 All fees for event and social activities are covered by event sponsorship for three invited boat team members.
- 3.2 Fees for additional team members and other regatta guests are listed with the social schedule below.

4 RACING SERIES

- 4.1 The regatta will consist of a 6 race series.



5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1** Registration: Thursday, September 24, 2015 from 12:00 pm to 8:00 pm
- 5.2** Dates of racing: Racing will occur on Friday, Saturday and Sunday of this event
- 5.3** The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is at 10:00 am, unless changed per sailing instructions.
- 5.4** No race shall start after Noon on Sunday.
- 5.5** Social Schedule and extra fees:
- a. Thursday, September 24, 2015: Pork Chop Dinner – cost per person \$20. Cash bar available. Welcome toast to occur at 7:00 pm.
 - b. Friday, September 25, 2015: Harken-sponsored event at Harken World Headquarters 6:00 dinner, wine, beer provided. Cash bar available. Team introductions and plant tours.
 - c. Saturday, September 26, 2015: Steak Dinner and introduction of participants and mystery guests – cost per person \$75. Cash bar available.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1** The sailing instructions will be available after Noon on September 24, 2015 at regatta headquarters.

7 VENUE

- 7.1** Regatta events will be held at the Pewaukee Yacht Club.
- 7.2** Competition will be on the navigable waters of Pewaukee Lake.

8 THE COURSES

- 8.1** The courses to be sailed will be as follows: Windward / Leeward with the number of legs for each race posted by the Race Committee.

9 SCORING

- 9.1** The Low Point system as defined in Rule A4 will apply.
- 9.2** One Completed race is required to constitute a series.
- 9.3** No scores will be excluded. This modifies Rule A2.
- 9.4** A boat that starts but does not finish will be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats that finished. This changes RRS A4.2.

10 RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 10.1** Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.



11 PRIZES

11.1 Prizes will be awarded for participation. Specific race and recognition awards will be listed at the time of registration.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

12.1 Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Participants in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (the organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any participant, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each participant, or in the case of minors, each participant's parent or guardian agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such participant's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
