Getting Started with the CHANGE Viewer

Quick Guide: Tips for Using the CHANGE Viewer

Launch CHANGE Viewer

1. Open a web browser and visit: www.climatechangehumanhealth.org/changeviewer
2. Save the CHANGE Viewer to a location you can access later.
 - a. On the website, **right click** on the “Launch CHANGE Viewer” button.
 - b. Select **Save Link As** (or Save Target As) and save it to your Desktop.
3. Directly Launching the CHANGE Viewer from the website save the CHANGE Viewer file (Beta_WMSLayerManager-1.jnlp) to your Downloads folder. It’s best to save it to a location you access frequently for future use.

Navigating the CHANGE Viewer

1. Click on the **Activity** tab and select the activity theme of interest. The Activity theme tab contains access to data needed to complete the activity.
2. To make a layer appear, you must **turn the layer on** by checking the box.
3. When a data layer is turned on in the Activity tab, the **legend** and data layer will display in the **Map** tab.
4. **Data layers display based on the order they were turned on.**
5. Unchecking a layer in the Map tab will turn the layer off, making it no longer visible.
6. At times you will need to **switch between the Activity tab and the Map tab** to turn on and off layers.
7. At times you will need to **turn off a layer in the Activity tab** and then turn it back on to **display it as the top layer**.
8. **For information about the data, visit Help** in the CHANGE Viewer and access the Data Reference.
