### Their importance to The Suffolk Sanctuary

In addition, through many and varied conservation & education projects, our aim is to spread the word about the vital importance of preserving our native birds of prey & the ecological balance they help to maintain.

Further, the efforts of the Suffolk Owl Sanctuary extend far beyond the borders of our county through our "Saving Britain's Owls" scheme, which is making information about the need for, and the "best practice" of, raptor conservation throughout the United Kingdom.

Leaving a legacy to the Sanctuary is a wonderful way to help ensure that the work of the Centre continues in years to come. Your solicitor can easily advise you about how to do this, or how to attach a codicil to an existing will.

### *Some Useful Terms regarding Bequests & Legacies*

#### **Inheritance Tax**

Inheritance Tax is usually paid on an estate when somebody dies, if the estate is valued over the threshold of £325,000. Gifts to charities are deducted from the estate before the tax is calculated, which can mean paying less inheritance tax.

#### **Estate**

Your estate is the total value of everything you own and will include any life insurance policies due to be paid out after your demise.

#### **Net Estate**

Your net estate is the total value of everything you own after any specific gifts, costs for managing the estate and inheritance tax have been deducted.

## Beneficiaries

These are the people you want to leave a gift or sum of money to in your Will.

## Executors

Your executors are the people you have assigned in your Will to sort out your estate and to ensure that everything is done in accordance with your wishes.

## Legacy

If you choose to leave someone a particular gift, such as jewellery or property in your Will, this is called a specific legacy. A fixed sum of money is called a pecuniary legacy.

## Residuary Legacy

You may choose to leave someone a certain percentage or share of your net estate. The amount that person receives will then depend on what the total of your estate is after all taxes and expenses have been paid.

## Getting advice on leaving a bequest or legacy

- Free and independent advice about making a Will is available from a number of organisations such as the Citizens Advice Bureau and Age Concern.
- You can also write your own will on a pre-printed form available from stationery shops or downloaded from the internet.
- It's important if you are leaving money to a charity in your Will that you make it clear exactly which charity you want to receive your gift.
- There is an organisation called 'Will Aid' that will help you to make a Will and gives you access to professional advice from volunteering solicitors in return for a suggested donation to charity.
- **We strongly recommend that you take the advice of a solicitor when writing your Will to ensure that the correct wording is used and your wishes are clear!**
