Meadow Creek Interceptor Repairs

Dear **Resident/Property Owner**,

The Rivanna Water and Sewer Authority replaced the Meadow Creek Interceptor sewer system between 2010 and 2012. Recent inspections have determined some minor deficiencies that could lead to maintenance and operational issues in the future if we do not take a proactive approach now to resolve them. As a result, a number of point repairs will be performed on the interceptor at various locations along its alignment. We at Rivanna Water and Sewer Authority remain dedicated to treating wastewater from Charlottesville and Albemarle County residents for the public's health and so that it can safely return to the aquatic environment. We appreciate your cooperation in helping us fulfill this mission.


You are receiving this letter due to the work being performed on this interceptor within easements around your property or place of residence. The sewer repairs will take place in easements located in Greenbrier Park back behind your house, but the contractor will be accessing this area via roads located around your property. If access through your property was necessary in order for the contractor to perform his work, you would have been contacted separately regarding that matter.

While the construction work will be taking place down in Greenbrier Park, the contractor may have equipment or material temporarily staged in the road as it is being transported down to the construction site. Under no circumstances will equipment or material be left in the roadway overnight and only minimal disruptions to traffic are anticipated, with no more than short-term single lane closures.

The contractor plans to begin bringing material and equipment to the site on April 4, 2016, with construction continuing until the first week of May. During this time, all attempts will be made to minimize any disturbance to your daily routine and your property. Following construction activities, all areas will be restored to pre-existing conditions.

We understand that this type of activity can be a disturbance and will make every effort to minimize the impacts on the residents and property owners in this area. We thank you in advance for your patience and understanding as we work to improve our sanitary sewer collection system and maintain a high level of service to City of Charlottesville customers.
